At 6:03 pm, Chairman Marc Komorsky called the Board of Fire Commissioners regular meeting for Tuesday, November 24th, 2020, to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. He noted that Commissioner McCord would be retiring from the Board and said it has been a pleasure to work with Bob (McCord) on the Board. Komorsky then said that he would step aside and let McCord run the meeting for the evening. McCord took on control of the meeting as Acting Chairman.

Treasurer –

<u>CASH POSITION:</u> Treasurer Mark Pozniak reviewed Cash Position as of 10/31/20: Operating Cash - \$3,365,282.21, Reserve & Restricted - \$1,372,655.84, and Total Cash - \$4,737,938.05. He noted that all bank accounts have been reconciled and are in the Board's possession for review and audit. He pointed out that he erroneously moved funds into the Trust & Agency account instead of the General Fund Checking but said that has been corrected and will reflect on the next statement.

Upon a MOTION made by Komorsky and SECONDED by Burns, the Board RESOLVED to make the budget adjustments recommended by the treasurer. Burns – Aye, Komorsky – Aye, Sassi – Aye, Piehler – Aye, McCord – Aye. **Motion Carried**.

Chief –

<u>VEHICLES</u>: Chief Tim O'Connor reported that during the recent brush fire a Pleasant Valley brush truck was damaged when responding as mutual aid. He said that Pleasant Valley will be getting an estimate to us for the damage. Short discussion followed regarding responsibility for the insurance coverage.

Next O'Connor reported that 47-72 had new tires installed and that 47-98 has been moved out to Station 1 to be used for Department business.

<u>PERSONNEL:</u> O'Connor informed the Board that there is now a chairman for the Volunteer Membership Committee and inquiries are now being directed to him.

<u>GRANTS</u>: The Chief noted that he has submitted the grant back on the 13th for about \$100,000 and is now waiting to see the results. He thanked everyone who helped put the data together. O'Connor then passed along the notice about a SAFER grant opening soon and said he would keep the Board informed as he found out dates.

<u>IMT:</u> O'Connor said that COVID is ramping up and so a smaller version of the Incident Management Team met and went through the COVID policy from earlier in the year and determined what worked and what didn't. He said they will use the State's zone determinations to trigger parts of the District's COVID responses.

<u>GOVDEALS:</u> The chief noted that Lt. Champion has been steadily working on GovDeals to get rid of the surplus items.

STRYKER POWERLOAD: Chief O'Connor said the Board was given estimates on the powerloads (stretchers) from Stryker. He reviewed the three prices and what they covered and said Styker agreed to honor their last agreement for a 5 year payment plan with no interest. Lengthy discussion followed regarding the reliability of the stretchers and other pros and cons. Sassi asked if they could get a price for one of the stretchers and try it before committing to all three. Further discussion followed about personal experiences with the stretchers and how to pay for them.

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Upon a MOTION by Sassi and SECONDED by Komorsky, the Board RESOLVED to table the discussions pending the updated quote and clarification on the financing period. Short discussion followed on waiting until COVID calmed down. Burns – Aye, Komorsky – Aye, Sassi – Aye, Piehler – Aye, McCord – Aye. **Motion Carried**.

<u>PURCHASING:</u> O'Connor said that Frazier had the ability to make small purchases for the buildings or vehicles so he requested similar authorization for the lieutenants. Short discussion followed.

Upon a MOTION made by Komorsky and SECONDED by Piehler, the Board RESOLVED to authorized the Lieutenants to spend up to \$500.00 per purchase on items needed for building repairs or vehicle repairs. Burns – Aye, Komorsky – Aye, Piehler – Aye, Sassi – Aye, McCord – Aye. **Motion Carried**.

<u>RENEWALS:</u> EMS Administrator Michael Benenati reported that he has received the New York State Department of Health Ambulance Operating Certificate and Controlled Substances renewal packet and he is working on getting them completed. He also noted that COVID is heating up again and asked everyone to be careful.

 Building Repairs/Repair Requests – Komorsky said that he asked the engineer if they had the roof dimensions. Discussion followed regarding what is needed to put the roof project out to hid

Next Chief O'Connor noted that the siren has been removed at Station 1 but the pole cannot be removed because the parking lot lights run through that pole. He said that the doorbell has been installed at Station 1. Short discussion followed regarding the door code at Station 1.

O'Connor said he got prices to replace the tank at Station 2 plus ones to install a new diesel tank at Station 1. Discussion followed regarding the tanks and the time frame to get additional quotes on the projects.

The chief noted that the roof at Station 2 was repaired in two place, the ready room baseboard heat was completed, and the vent in the upstairs bathroom should be finished in the next couple of days.

O'Connor then expressed concern about keeping up with the amount of mechanic work that Frazier did. He requested to hang on to the hydraulic lifts for a while in case they may be needed in the future and said Lieutenant Champion would present a way to store them. Lt. Champion reviewed options for containers that could be used for storage initially then later for training purposes. He said the lifts would need a high top container (9 ½ ft high) for \$3500.00. Short discussion followed regarding how the container could be used for training and the condition of the container.

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Upon a MOTION made by Komorsky and SECONDED by Piehler, the Board RESOLVED to approve the purchase of a used 9 ½ ft. tall 40 ft. container up to \$3500.00. Burns – Aye, Komorsky – Aye, Piehler – Aye, Sassi – Aye, McCord – Aye. **Motion Carried**.

Lt. Champion then gave a report of the status of the items on the back tables and the items pending on GovDeals.

Komorsky said he wanted to take a moment, on behalf of the Board, to thank Bob McCord for all of his years of dedication and service. He said that this would be McCord's last meeting.

At 7:14 pm, McCord stated for the record that he was resigning from the Board of Fire Commissioners at that moment.

Upon a MOTION made by Komorsky and SECONDED by Sassi, the Board RESOLVED to appoint Mr. (Anthony) Pignataro as a fire commissioner to complete Bob's (McCord) term. Burns – Aye, Komorsky – Aye, Piehler – Aye, Sassi – Aye. **Motion Carried**.

Secretary Le then administered the Oath of Office to newly appointed Commissioner Pignataro.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

At 7:17 pm, upon a MOTION made by Sassi and SECONDED by Burns, the Board RESOLVED to go into Executive Session to discuss three personnel issues and two contractual from the Chief. Burns – Aye, Sassi – Aye, Piehler – Aye, Pignataro – Aye, Komorsky – Aye. **Motion Carried**.

OPEN SESSION & PREGNANCY LEAVE POLICY:

At 8:36 pm, the Board resumed Public Session.

Upon a MOTION made by Sassi and SECONDED by Burns, the Board RESOLVED to authorize Chairman Komorsky, or if he is unavailable, any commissioner of his designation, to execute the Pregnancy Leave Policy subject to the amendments made by counsel. Burns – Aye, Piehler – Aye, Sassi – Aye, Pignataro – Aye, Komorsky – Aye. **Motion Carried**.
